Read Galatians 1:1-12

Week 1: Freedom's Call... From Confusion

Questions from the Text:

1. Describe Paul's mood or frame of mind when he wrote this. What caused this attitude? Does it seem justified?
2. Paul offers here an outline of the gospel. Does this outline seem complete? Why or why not?
3. According to Vs.6-7, any change to the gospel makes it null and void. Why?
4. Why were the Galatian Christians confused?



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Applying the text:

1. What throws us into confusion? What do we look to for life and freedom other than the Gospel?
2. How do people “add to the gospel” today in ways that diminish it’s power?
3. Would Paul consider the gospel the most important thing in the world? Why or why Not?
4. How has the Gospel delivered you from confusion this past week?
5. What is God inviting you to believe?
6. Write the Gospel in your own words. We will compare it our understanding of the gospel at the end of the series.

Read Martin Luther’s preface to Galatians.

Mark “?” for something that raised a question in your mind.

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
